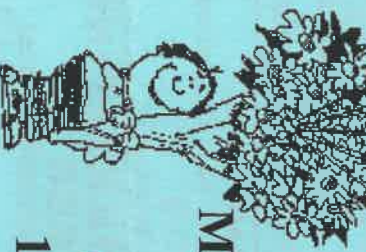

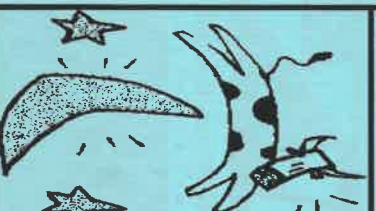

Village of McBride Taps Infrastructure Funding - McBride - Improved water service for the Village of McBride is the first infrastructure project approved under Forest Renewal BC's new guidelines for its forest community economic development program.

McBride is receiving \$100,000 from Forest Renewal BC to replace undersized pipes supplying the Tom Ryan Cedar sawmill. Installing a 25-centimetre-wide water main, more than 750 metres of new pipe and three fire hydrants will increase fire protection.

"Supporting forest communities is a big part of Forest Renewal BC's mandate, and it's gratifying to see money reinvested into a small community like McBride to help build its economy," said Prince George - Mt. Robson MLA Lois Boone.

The improved water supply will allow the mill to expand its operations to include producing cedar mulch. The expansion is expected to result in eight new jobs.

"The infrastructure component was added to the forest community economic development program this year to facilitate this kind of economic progress," said Kathy Chopik, executive director of Forest Renewal BC's communities and workforce business unit.

McBride Mayor Mike Frazier said: "The upgraded water service passes through the village's industrial-zoned area, improving its attraction as a site for potential business growth. This is a good project for our town."

The forest community economic development program requires cost-shared funding. Each project must meet one more criteria, which include jobs created, businesses created or expanded, joint ventures established, and investment capital leveraged.

Forest Renewal BC announced last April it was expanding community investment program guidelines to allow funds that previously had been available for planning purposes only to be used in capital and infrastructure projects. Funding is available to a maximum of 50 per cent of eligible costs or \$100,000 per project, whichever is less.
