### POLICE REPORT

January 20, 2001 there was a report of theft of a motor vehicle. The vehicle was later located no theft had occurred and no charges were laid.

January 22, McBride RCMP received a report from a local Service Station that there was a gas and dash. The large blue sports car, pumped gas into his car, dropped the nozzle on the ground and drove off, heading east on Highway 16.

On the 22, police received a report of a single vehicle accident on Highway 16, 10 km west of the Dome Diner. The vehicle was upside down in the ditch, with no occupants in or around the area. Investigation revealed the vehicle was stolen from an Edmonton car dealer and the licence plate had been stolen from another vehicle in Edmonton. Neither had been reported stolen until after they had been recovered. Investigation revealed it was also the same vehicle involved in theft of gas earlier in the day. There are no suspects at this time.

On January 22 McBride RCMP responded to a report of numerous shots fired at Dome Creek. Police attended the area and as a result a male was taken into custody. Three firearms were seized and a marijuana grow operation was uncovered. 24 mature plants with 24 clones were seized along with the hydroponic equipment. Investigation is continuing and charges are pending against a Dome Creek resident.

On January 23, McBride RCMP responded to a single motor vehicle accident with a deer on Highway 16 at 1st Ave. There were no injuries.

On January 24, police received a report of harassing phone calls. Investigation is ongoing. People are reminded if they get harassing calls to log the calls and call the police for assistance. Hang up do not engage the caller in conversation.

On January 25, McBride RCMP responded to a request for assistance from the Volunteer Fire Department as they battled a fire at the McBride Hotel. The RCMP responded for traffic control. The source of the fire came from the bar area and is believed to be an electrical fire.

The remainder of the calls were for general assistance and routine in nature.
