

Let's shed some light on driving infractions. Dear Editor - Whe I meet an oncoming vehicle at night, and the units switch from hig beam, to low beam lamps. I ask the following questions; \*Are those auxiliary driving lamps? The Motor Vehicle Act say under Schedule #4093. "No auxiliary lamps are allowed on lo"

\*Are those fog lamps? The M.V. Act schedule #411-4 tells me no fog lamps are allowed when no fog is present.

\*Are those daytime running lamps? If so, what are they doing little in the control of the c

\*Are the additional lamps default to low beam each ti witches from high to low beam? (Poor Design.)

\*Is there a visual warning to the driver that the extra lights are lit?

\*Does the operator know where the switch is?

\*Where is the enforcement of the existing M.V. regulations that re supposed to control dangerous traffic hazards such as double the light being projected into the eyes of oncoming motorists? (Factors in accident causes.)

\*We have had the RCMP warnings, now let's have the required citations or whatever it takes to get the attention of drivers that do not care about oncoming drivers and the blinding effect that additional light on low beam produces.

\*Or pin down and solve the vehicle condition that causes the effect.
