**POLICE REPORT**

On January 27, 2001, McBride RCMP was dispatched to a house fire in Dunster, shortly after midnight. The house was completely destroyed by the fire. No one was injured in the incident. It is believed that the fire originated in the chimney.  
On January 28, McBride RCMP were called to a disturbance at the Traveller's Inn in the early morning hours. The manager of the Hotel was asking some patrons to keep the noise down. This resulted in an altercation between all parties involved. Investigation is continuing.  
On January 30, at approximately 19:40 hours, McBride RCMP responded to a single motor vehicle accident involving a moose on Highway 16 near the Holmes River. The three occupants were treated for minor injuries at the McBride Hospital.  
On January 31, McBride RCMP were dispatched to a single vehicle accident 60 kms west of McBride on Hwy. 16. The investigation revealed that the two male occupants, both from Prince George, were travelling to Calgary when they lost control of their vehicle. The vehicle crossed the center line and rolled over in the ditch. The occupants were not wearing their seat belts and were thrown out of the vehicle. The vehicle came to rest on its roof with the driver partly stuck underneath. He suffered on head, neck, and back injuries while the passenger who ended up nearly 30 feet from the vehicle suffered of massive head and back injuries. The passenger was immediately transported to Prince George Hospital. The driver was first treated at McBride Hospital but was later transferred to Prince George Hospital. Driving too fast for the road conditions has been determined to be the cause of the accident.

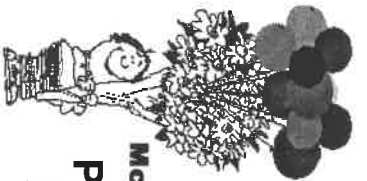

McIntosh Falls, which is on the lower slopes of Bell Mountain just  
west of McBride. The terrain is fairly flat and the fact that it will  
be a group hike means as long as you are not breaking trail, it  
should be fairly easy going. It should only take a few hours, but  
anyone who wants more may continue on past the falls. The  
Ozalanka Alpine Club is a hiking club whose activities is generally  
limited to spring and summer activities, but since snowshoeing is  
currently the fastest growing winter sport, we thought we would  
give it a go. Anyone who is interested in the snowshoe hike is  
welcome to participate. If you have no snowshoes, maybe we can  
find you some, or if you would rather ski, the trail is skiable.  
Participants should meet at 10:00 AM, Sunday, Feb. 11th, at 3km  
on Bell Mountain Rd. Bring yourself a lunch. If you have any  
questions give Elaine Gillette a call at 569-2643.

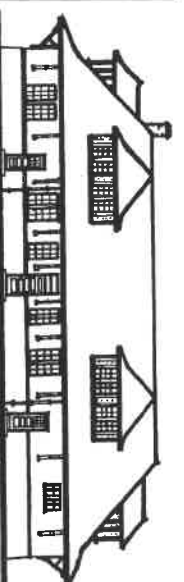
