## YELLOWHEAD SKI CLUB

**Festive Grand Opening - Pine Lake Cabin** - On Sunday, February 18, the Yellowhead Ski Club hosted a Poker Ski Run to its newly completed Pine Lake Cabin on Bell Mountain near McBride. Seventy five skiers followed a beautiful five kilometre course through two sunny meadows to reach the cabin. Five one gallon ice cream pails were nailed to trees along the way. Participants drew one card from each pail. Anticipating possible "cheaters" race organizers skewed the cards in the pails, thwarting serious gambler types. The best poker hand won the grand prize. Participants were rewarded with warm soup, barbecued hot dogs and refreshments at the end of the course on Pine Lake. \*Kjell Valestrand, ski club president, addressed the participants from the staging area directly in front of the cabin. Draw Prizes were given out and Thank You's were made to ski club volunteers who spent many weekends falling trees, burning brush, digging foundations and hauling materials through the meadows to the site. A Thank You was expressed to the Province of British Columbia and to M.L.A. Loise Boone for providing a cost sharing initiative through the Community Spirit 2000 program which was made available to celebrate the spirit of BC during the millennium.

\*Rykes Construction was the general contractor of the project and Tony Rykes was a significant donor of labour and materials. The Ministry of Forests contributed some helicopter time. The 46 members of the Yellowhead Ski Club provided the grant work needed to complete the structure at the scenic site. \*To open the festivities Keith Berg from Dunster played his 12 foot long alpine horn to draw the attention of the participants. After the opening ceremonies skiers participated in a sun soaked game of snow volleyball and fun relays on Pine Lake. \*The Pine Lake Cabin is the culminating project of a long term community plan to develop a Nordic facility on Bell Mountain. The cabin has an air tight stove, propane cooking facilities, a sleeping loft and a waxing porch. The Yellowhead Ski Club now has it's long awaited "on site" warm up facility located at the hub of the ski trail network. The cabin can be accessed from two trails leading from the 5km parking lot on the Bell Mountain Road which was recently upgraded by Forest Renewal BC and is maintained by the Ministry of Forests. \*By the way, the Poker Run was won by Ella, age 10, with an incredible poker hand of five threes! Prizes for the event were donated by Olympia Ski and Cycle in Prince George, McBride Home Hardware, Canadian Mountain Holidays, and Crescent Spur Helicopter Skiing. Synra Wood Products provided the firewood for the event and Glenda Thompson and Nancy Bachrach provided the excellent soup. \*Project co-ordinator, Kjell Valestrand, maintains that with the recent addition of the Pine Lake Cabin the Bell Mountain Nordic Trail Facility is now a significant community asset and will provide a lasting economic benefit for the Robson Valley.

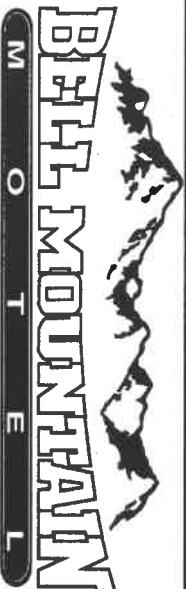
