

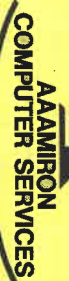

PRESS RELEASE

McBride RCMP Press Release for March 21, 2001 - at approximately 11:00 a.m., the RCMP Detachment received a report of a snowmobiler buried in an avalanche in the Renshaw Mountain area. The initial investigation revealed there were up to fourteen persons sledging in the area when an avalanche struck at about 10:00 a.m. One male was on the face of the mountain when the slide struck and was subsequently buried. The other members of the party began searching immediately and sent for help. McBride Search and Rescue were dispatched and attended the scene by helicopter. A second Search and Rescue Team was prepared to travel by sled. When the first team arrived by Helicopter the victim had been located and several persons were already performing CPR on him.

The victim was transported by helicopter to the McBride and District Hospital where Justin Robert LEIGH, age 21, of Edmonton, Alberta, was pronounced dead on arrival.

McBride RCMP Press Release for March 25, 2001 - On March 25, 2001 the McBride and Valemount RCMP were advised of an avalanche at the Horsesy Creek Glacier, which is located approximately 40 kilometres east of McBride. The avalanche occurred at approximately 12:40 hours. A group of snowmobilers from Alberta were riding in the area at the time.

The avalanche claimed the life of a 22 year old man from Radway, Alberta. He became the second victim of avalanches in four days in the McBride area. Another snowmobiler was caught in the avalanche, however he was partially buried and was able to free himself and didn't suffer of any injury.

THE McBRIDE RCMP as well as the Canadian Avalanche Association would like to remind the public who are snowmobiling in the mountains that the avalanche risk is high at the present time. Be prepared, know the area, carry probes, shovels, and wear pips. Do not venture in areas above your abilities and experience.

DEMOLITION

Over the Spring Break, some of you were travelling, some of you were at work, and some of us were watching the demolition of the old Elementary School. It was torn down on March 13 by R.B. Hatchard and his Crew. Rex was one of the ones operating an Excavator to tear it down, slowly, and everything seemed to go smoothly. It was intense to see whether or not it was going to fall the wrong direction onto the new school, but with a sigh of relief from everyone watching, it didn't. The crew has a large mess to clean up, but it's going along quickly and in no time there will be no sign of the building, just all the memories.

DOWSING

Dowsing has been used for centuries as a method for finding water, treasures, gold, metals, people, animals and to tell the past and the future. In fact dowsing has been used for nearly 7,000 years and probably even longer. It was used by both the ancient Egyptians and Chinese. In the middle ages it was used in Europe to find coal deposits and water. In the 20th century dowsing has been used in archeological and geological work, and by utility companies in locating damaged pipes and cables. The traditional tool of the dowsing is a forked rod made of wood. Certain wood such as Hazel, Willow, Ash and Rowan are the best. Many dowsers prefer to work with a pendulum on a string. The dowsing attunes themselves to what is being sought usually through visualization. The dowsing holds the forked end of the rod making sure palms are turned upwards. The dowsing walks until the rod trembles and dips down marking the spot. In the case of dowsing with a pendulum the dowsing hangs the pendulum over a map.
