ROBSON VALLEY HOME SUPPORT SOCIETY

The Robson Valley Home Support Society values all Seniors and considers them to be important members of our Community and we are pleased to be able to assist them when we can. Below are some of our services with Seniors in mind. If you would like to know more about any of our programs, visit us at the Home Support Office on Main Street, or Telephone us at 569-2256. ***Equipment Loan:** We have an extensive stock of bath and mobility aids (walkers, raised toilet seats, bathlifts etc.) that can be borrowed on long-term loan at no charge. ***Handyman Program:** provides help with minor household repairs, painting and yard work at a very nominal hourly fee. ***Lifeline Program:** enables Seniors to remain at home alone without fear, as with a simple push of a button (worn on a necklace or wristband) they can summon immediate assistance. ***Meals-on-Wheels:** volunteers deliver hot lunches for a small charge to the homes of Seniors or disable persons. ***Home Support:** trained and caring home support workers provide personal care and housekeeping services. Most people who qualify receive services at no cost, but depending on a person's financial situation, a small contribution may be charged. To see if you are eligible for home support contact **Mary Betkus, the Continuing Care Nurse, at 569-0330 local 218;** she will visit to assess your situation and needs. *We would like to wish all the Robson Valley Seniors a Happy and Healthy Summer!
