POLICE REPORT

June 18, 2001, the RCMP received a call of an injury accident on Highway 16 west of town. The driver of the van was east bound travelling behind a semi-flatted unit. The semi had made a right turn and the van proceeded to go around the unit. A vehicle travelling west bound forced the van back into the lane and the van clipped the end of the flatted and went off into the right ditch and turned over on it's side. The injuries were minor and the driver was released from the hospital. There are no charges being laid.

June 18, 2001, another complaint of an accident this time with a moose. The driver from Alberta was assisted by Prince George Detachment. There were minor injuries to one passenger in the vehicle.

June 18, 2001. RCMP responded to an alarm at a local business on Main street. Upon attendance of a member the alarm was concluded as false.

June 19, 2001, a blue curling bag containing 2 open face spinning reels and rods, 1 fly rod and 1 fly reel were turned in the RCMP Detachment. The owner apparently was driving on Highway 16 and the bag fell off of their truck and landed near King Creek on the side of the highway. The owner called to report it missing and then claimed same by identifying.

June 19, 2001, a complaint was received of vandalism to a vehicle that was parked at Little LaSalle Rd., while the owners were at the lake. The passenger side vent window was smashed, but nothing was taken.

June 20, 2001, a concerned driver reported a deceased bear on Highway 16 east near Tete Jaune. The bear was lying in the west bound lane causing traffic to swerve into the opposite lane. The Tete Jaune Northlands office was informed and the matter was dealt with. The RCMP urge motorists to report any wildlife that have been hit and are lying on the highway as it poses a traffic hazard.

June 21, 2001, The RCMP responded to an alarm at the McBride Elementary School in the early morning hours. The alarm was concluded as false upon attendance after the property was checked thoroughly.

June 21, 2001, during a routine check, an RCMP member noticed an odour of cannabis coming from a stopped vehicle. A search resulted in the seizure of paraphernalia. One adult and one youth were arrested.

June 22, 2001, a complaint was received in the early morning hours from a local resident that a vehicle was doing doughnuts on Main Street. Patrols failed to locate the suspect vehicle. The matter is under investigation.
