LETTER TO THE EDITOR

Dear Editor:

The letter I am writing today is not just for the editor, it is for all Valley residents that are interested in having a hospital in McBride. At the moment McBride Hospital is a relay station, you come to the hospital and you are forwarded to somewhere else.

I feel that the next step will be the closing of the hospital. I have been assured by Shirley Bond, Vic Chicoine, Teresa Smith and our new Director of Patient Care Dorothy Schriller, this is not the case. I am told that by September we will be accepting acute care patients once again.

The shortage of nurses I am told is the problem. Have they already hired more for September? How can the NIRHB be so sure that September is the month of reopening or will they then say "McBride managed just fine without acute care!"

Some people will remember the days of the Red Cross when two nurses had to handle everything. The hospital was kept open then. I can remember times after the town took over the hospital that it was short of nurses, but it was still kept open. This hospital of that time had more acute care beds than it has today. Others may remember the work it took for the community to form a hospital society and take over the hospital. All this has been taken from us. It seems to me that less health care is delivered at the hospital today than we received fifty years ago.

After all the assurances I have been given, I still do not feel secure in the thought that the acute care beds will open in September. More can be done, but only if we all pull together & speak out. If by working can we keep our hospital? I don't know. The residents of this Valley worked hard for this hospital. I feel we should do the same, by working together & speaking out. I would like to hear how the Valley residents feel about it 569-2309.

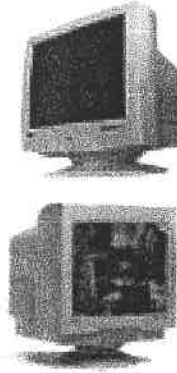
