**How do you stand on gun control and registration of firearms?** Does allowing people to own guns increase or deter violent crime? The recent book arrival, More Guns, Less Crime by legal scholar John Lott presents "the most rigorously comprehensive data analysis ever done on crime." \*Two recent fiction arrivals by popular authors are: P is for Peril by Sue Grafton and Raven's End by Ben Gadd. \*Two fiction books that I found to be quite special are: Plainsong by Kent Haruf and The Samurai's Garden by Gail Tsutomiyama. Set in a small town in Colorado, Plainsong is a story "about people's ability to adapt and heal the wounds of isolation by moving toward community." The Samurai's Garden is set in 1937/1938; a young Chinese man is sent from Hong Kong to his family's summer home in Tamari, Japan to recover from tuberculosis.
