POLICE REPORT

August 11, 2001 - RCMP received a report of an mva with a moose near the Dunster road turn off. There were no injuries and the file was reported for insurance purposes only. There was minimal damage to the vehicle.

August 11, 2001 - RCMP received a report of a non injury accident on Mountainview road. It was found that a youth had taken the family vehicle for a joy ride. The family and the youth were spoken to. The damage is estimated at \$8000.00

August 13, 2001 - A complaint was made of theft from a vehicle. Numerous CD's were stolen along with a cell phone and cd player. If anyone may have information or was a witness to any suspicious activities, please call the RCMP at (250)569-2255.

August 13, 2001 - RCMP received a report of a possible shop-lift at a local business on main street. Patrols for the suspects were negative and the staff were informed on ways to deal with similar situations and how to spot suspicious looking people.

August 13, 2001 - Numerous reports of sighting a wounded sow and her two cubs have been received. The areas they have been spotted are Zeidler drive and also bridge road. Patrols for the bear have been made and have been negative. If you see this family of bears, (the mother has a bad limp in the hind leg) they are asked to please call the RCMP and NOT scare the bear away into the bush.

August 13, 2001 - RCMP received a complaint of an alarm at another local business. This time there was a suspect. Upon attendance a little bird was spotted flying around in the inside of the building. Upon investigation there was no point of entry observed. Amounts of diesel and oil were spilled from the tank and the matter is under investigation with The Ministry of Environment.
