## POLICE REPORT

**August 22, 2001,** A complaint was received of three rifles disposed of in the garbage bins at Raven road. With the new gun laws that are being put into effect, citizens are worried about disposing of their firearms. We URGE all gun owners who want to dispose of their firearms in a proper manner, to please bring them into the RCMP. There is NO criminal charge for bringing these in along with ammunition. We cannot stress it enough that disposing of them by just throwing them out can lead to criminal charges because of unsafe disposal and handling. Please think about the children. If your child was throwing away garbage and came into possession of a weapon, there could be serious injuries or even death.  
**August 23, 2001,** A complaint was received of vandalism to some of the property at the local Bird Watch. Spray paint was used to spray the new table, the parking barrier and the ground. This is senseless damage and is not necessary, the people of McBride and the Village work hard to provide places like these for the public to view.
