POLICE REPORT

FATAL MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT - On August 1, 2001 at approximately 19:15 hours, the McBride RCMP were dispatched to a single motor vehicle accident a few kilometres west of town. The investigation revealed that the vehicle was travelling eastbound on Hwy. 16. On approach of the CN overpass the vehicle crossed the center line and drove onto the shoulder on the north side of the highway. The driver was unable to bring the vehicle back on the roadway. The vehicle came to rest on its side underneath the overpass near the railroad tracks.

There were 4 occupants in the vehicle at the time of the accident: all Valemount residents. 41 year old Thomas George BOOTH was pronounced dead at the scene. His wife, Crysle suffered of severe back injuries and was later transported to Vancouver General Hospital where her condition is currently being assessed. Their two children: 3 yr. old Taylor and 1 yr. old Mackenzie were treated at McBride Hospital for minor injuries and later released. The cause of the accident is still unknown. The investigation continues.
