FALL MUSHROOM FORAY

Learn about mushrooms of the Robson Valley, Saturday, September 22, 2001. Mushrooms are diverse and mysterious, delicious and nutritious, dangerous and poisonous, beautiful and enticing, ugly and repulsive.

Whether mushrooms are your passion or you are just a little curious about them, join us for a wonderful day exploring their ecology and diversity. If you were on our spring foray in June, we guarantee that the mushrooms will be different this time. If you missed the spring foray, join us now!

Leaders for the day include mushroom experts from the Ministry of Forests, Canadian Forest Service, and private consultants.

Introduction to mushrooms 10:00 - 12:00 Dunster Hall

This morning session will include presentations describing the diversity of mushrooms and fungi. Colour slides of mushrooms will illustrate the presentations. Mushrooms collected from the Robson Valley will also be identified and on display. Learn the basics of mushroom identification!
