

PRESS RELEASE

The cuts to jobs and services within our province that were announced on Thursday, January 17, 2002, left our Village reeling from shock. While Council is in agreement that government should be doing Core Reviews and looking for ways to become more efficient, nobody suspected that the cuts would be so deep or that they would impact our Village to such an extent. The Mayor and Council have met several times since Thursday to discuss the extent of the cuts and to develop a strategy to try to mitigate the effects. Council has asked some of our major employers and the Chamber of Commerce to assist them in developing a business plan to present to Government.

The issues facing smaller municipalities are not the same ones facing the larger ones and we want to ensure that this government understands what issues our community is facing in the next couple of years. We believe that to reach this government, we must put together a solid business case, with some viable, workable options for them to consider. It is unrealistic to imagine that we can cause the government to reverse their decision. However, with solid facts and figures that will stand the test of scrutiny, we may be able to be the architects of our own future. This community needs a government presence and we believe that a case can be made for it.
