- The sooner you start investing in an RRSP, the more time your money has to compound and grow. If, for example, you begin contributing \$100 a month at age 20 into an RRSP earning 8 per cent interest, by the age of 65 you will have approximately \$480,577.

- If you begin saving at age 25 by depositing \$100 a month and earn the same 8 percent interest, you will save approximately \$322,108, by age 65.

- If you wait 15 years and begin contributing \$100 a month at 8 per cent interest at age 35, you will have saved approximately \$140,855, when you turn 65. You'll accumulate almost \$340,000, less than you would have if you began your savings at age 20. Starting early really does make a difference.

#### Automatic Cheque Plan

- With an ACP, the money is automatically withdrawn from your chequing account and invested as you direct.
- You can set up an automatic chequing plan (ACP) for as little as \$50 a month. If the money is taken out at the beginning of each month, before you pay any other expenses, you likely won't even miss it.
