

Each year-student completes application forms, which include academic transcripts with an English translation, a teacher's recommendation, medical records, and an autobiographical essay written by the student. Passport - size photographs and photos of the student and his/her immediate family complete the application. The school they are to attend, the host family and the STS Representative will cach receive copies of the application forms.
