HOST FAMILIES NEEDED!

Student Travel Schools, a non - profit student exchange program, is accepting applications from families who are interested in hosting a high-school-age foreign exchange student for the up coming school semester.

The high school students, all proficient in the English language, will arrive in Canada at the end of January 2002 and will attend high school while living with their Canadian host families.

Host families provide students with a bed, meals and a loving family atmosphere. The students have medical insurance and spending money for the duration of their stay.

Families and students are provided with an STS representative who is available to answer questions and provide counselling support throughout the exchange experience.

All year-students are carefully selected and screened and must be recommended by teachers in their local schools. Only those students who can show academic interest and achievement, exemplary character, curiosity, adaptability and a good command of the English language are acceptable. Additionally each student must write a personal essay describing him/herself and satisfactorily complete a personal interview with a qualified STS Representative. The interviewer's written evaluation is of great importance to the acceptance process.

Each year-student completes application forms, which include academic transcripts with an English translation, a teacher's recommendation, medical records, and an autobiographical essay written by the student. Passport - size photographs and photos of the student and his/her immediate family complete the application. The school they are to attend, the host family and the STS Representative will each receive copies of the application forms.
