HAPPY ST. PATRICK'S DAY!!!

St. Patrick - Patron of Ireland

St. Patrick of Ireland is one of the world's most popular saints. Along with St. Nicholas and St. Valentine, the secular world shares our love of these saints. This is also a day when everyone's Irish. There are many legends and stories of St. Patrick. Patrick was born around 385 in Scotland, probably Kilpatrick. His parents were Calpurnius and Conchessa, who were Romans living in Britain in charge of the colonies. As a boy of fourteen or so, he was captured during a raiding party and taken to Ireland as a slave to herd and tend sheep. Ireland at this time was a land of Druids and pagans. He learned the language and practices of the people who held him and during his captivity, he turned to God in prayer. He wrote "The love of God and his fear grew in me more and more, as did the faith, and my soul was rosed, so that, in a single day, I have said as many as a hundred prayers and in the night, nearly the same." I prayed in the woods and on the mountain, even before dawn. I felt no hurt from the snow or ice or rain." Patrick's captivity lasted until he was twenty, at which time he escaped after having a dream from God in which he was told to leave Ireland by going to the coast. There he found some sailors who took him back to Britain, where he reunited with his family. He had another dream in which the people of Ireland were calling out to him "We beg you, holy youth, to come and walk among us once more." EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY PUBLIC WORKS SUPERVISOR/FOREMAN

Reporting to the Administrator, this is a working supervisor position responsible for directing public works staff and contractors in the water distribution, and sanitary sewer collection systems, road and drainage maintenance, parks and facilities maintenance and capital projects. Incumbent will be required to perform the duties involved in the various positions, including assisting with physical effort as required.

Summary of Duties & Responsibities: (Full job specs .available at Village office)

- Supervises and assists with preventive maintenance and repairs to water and sewer systems; installs and calibrates equipment including cleaning and inspection of lift station, pumps, reservoirs and lines. Ensures test procedures are done on a regular basis; assists in interpreting readings and results to make corrective adjustments.

- Supervision of Works Dept. personnel and contractors; prepares work plans and schedules, participates in staff hiring, training, and evaluation. Ensures compliance with safety regulations and Village policies.
- Prepares and maintains records, schedules and reports; assists with policy & procedure development, long and short range planning and budgeting. Ensures compliance with requirements of all regulatory bodies.

- Six years of progressively responsible work experience in the utilities or general maintenance and trade area, with a minimum of three years of supervisory experience.
