## COMING EVENTS

The McBride and Area Community Impact Task Force is hosting a second community meeting at McBride Secondary School Auditorium on Tuesday, May 21st starting at 7:30pm. The purpose of this meeting is to provide: 1. updated information on issues and concerns from the initial \ community meeting; 2. information on issues arising since the initial community meeting; 3. an opportunity for community input into future direction, growth and opportunity for McBride and Area. This meeting will involve smaller groups looking at opportunities and barriers that need to be addressed in order to realize opportunity. This meeting will begin to address the question "What is Your Vision of McBride - 5 Years From Today?"
