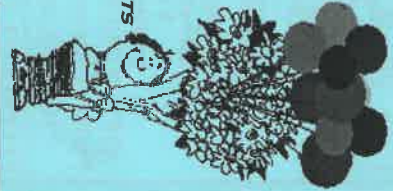

POLICE REPORT

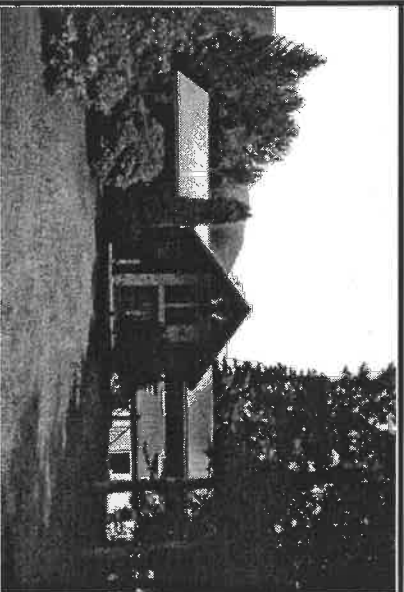
