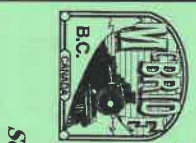

POLICE REPORT

June 22 - In the early morning hours RCMP received a report of a non injury mva with a moose on Hwy. 16 east of McBride near the Holmes River.

June 23 - Again in the early morning a report of another mva on Sansom Road was received. There were 4 occupants in the vehicle and 3 suffered minor injuries in the roll over. The driver was issued a 24 hour suspension.

June 23 - RCMP and ambulance attended a single motorcycle accident with a moose on Highway 16 east of Dunster. The driver from Massachusetts was semi conscious and then went into a full cardiac arrest. A paramedic from Prince George was at the scene and performed CPR until EMS arrived. The driver was pronounced dead at the McBride Hospital.

June 23 - RCMP received a complaint of an Impaired driver on 4th avenue. The driver was highly intoxicated and charged with Impaired driving and refuse a breathalyzer test.

June 24 - A complaint was received from an ex-conservation officer of a calf moose stuck in a barbed wire fence. Cst. WEBB attended the scene and helped release the calf.

June 24 - RCMP received a request for extra patrols at the Airport. One of the personal Hangars had a lock damaged although no entry was gained.

June 27 - A report of an mva with a deer was received on Highway 16 near Bluff Road. There was minimal damage to the vehicle and it is unknown if the deer survived the altercation because it was gone when a member attended.

We would like to remind everyone to use extra caution as there seem to be more animals on the road and the ditches in the summer and there have been extensive animal injuries in the past month on the Highway.
