## HEALTH NEWS

**Physician On-call coverage** has been modified with the new Master Agreement between the provincial government and the BC Medical Association. Effective September 1, 2002 physicians in both Valenmount and McBride sites will provide after-hours coverage to residents of the Robson Valley on a rotating basis, i.e., the two physicians in Valenmount will provide coverage for the Valley two evenings per week, while the three physicians in McBride will provide coverage three evenings per week. Weekend coverage will likewise be shared between the two sites. Patients from either community who need emergency health services after hours will be seen in the community from which the coverage is being provided. Lab/X-ray services will for the most part be provided out of the on-call physicians community. The drive between Valenmount and McBride is such that it meets provincial standards for this access, since the communities are considered to be within one hour of each other. Valley residents are encouraged to access the BC Nurses Health-Line as a first line of defence when they want medical advice but may not need to go immediately to the Emergency Department at either Valenmount or McBride. The toll-free number is 1-866-215-4700. Valley residents will continue to receive the care they need, but it is not sustainable to maintain small physician call groups in communities without large enough populations, because: a) experience has shown that high on-call frequency discourages physicians from settling down in a community, and results in increased physician turn-over. It also makes recruitment more difficult. b) A group of at least three or more physicians is the smallest size that is considered sustainable under the BCM/ABC government agreement. Emergency Health Services will continue to transfer seriously ill patients requiring medical care to the most appropriate facility. I'd like to reassure the public that patients with genuine emergencies will continue to receive the highest quality care in an appropriate and timely manner. I'd also recommend Valley residents deal with any less than emergent situations through their doctors' offices. Thank you. Charles Taylor, Health Services Administrator - Robson Valley.
