

POLICE REPORT

September 25, 2002 - RCMP received a series of complaints of heft from vehicles, and back yards, within the village in the late

evening early morning hours. The culprits used a variety of techniques to gain access to the locked and unlocked vehicles. The items that were taken included Stereos and various equipment, CD's, amps, tools, cell phone, 3 wallets, purse, cash, browning compound bow, bow and arrows, bicycle, stereo plate, cassette and c changer, ac/dc inverter and other miscellaneous items. Another vehicle had a window broken but nothing was taken. The McBride RCMP are currently doing an extensive investigation into this matter, and anyone with any information is asked to please contact the RCMP at (250)569-2255.

September 26, 2002 - In the early morning hours, RCMP received a report of a single semi roll over 15 km west of McBride on Highway 16. The driver swerved to miss a moose and ended up in the left ditch. There were no injuries although the vehicle is irreparable. Flag personnel were dispatched to the scene, to control traffic because re-bar was spilled over the highway.

On September 27, 2002 - at 11:15 hours, the McBride RCMP responded to a motor vehicle accident approximately 70 kilometres west of McBride - The investigation revealed that 72 year old Wesley Lorne ACORN of Prince George was driving his 1999 Chevrolet Tahoe eastbound on Highway 16 when he crossed the center line into the oncoming traffic lane. Mr. ACORN collided head on with a tractor trailer unit, which was travelling westbound at the time. The tractor unit ended up down a steep embankment and caught on fire after impact. The driver of the tractor unit suffered minor injuries. Mr. ACORN was pronounced dead at the scene. An autopsy is scheduled for September 30 in Prince George. The cause of the accident is still unknown at this time.

September 27, 2002 - A report of theft of a Craftsman riding lawn mower was received. The mower was stored in a garage at a local residence. The mower is valued at approximately \$1,800.00, there are no suspects or witnesses and is currently under investigation. The McBride RCMP would like to inform anyone wishing to apply


