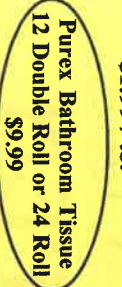

## POLICE REPORT

**School Bus Safety Awareness Week** October 21-25, 2002  
 - Personnel from the RCMP in Prince George, Mackenzie, and McBride will be participating in the national school bus safety awareness week scheduled for October 21-25 2002. During the school year, police respond to complaints from school bus drivers of motorists passing school buses with lights flashing. During the upcoming week, police will shadow school buses in the area. In an effort to detect offending drivers who ignore the stop signs and flashing lights. The fine for passing a stopped school bus with lights flashing is \$144.00. Remember that safety of our children is the most Important issue, and that as the daylight hours decrease and weather conditions worsen, the students will soon be entering and leaving the school buses in the dark, on cold and snow covered streets. The police are also requesting parents to ensure that their children obey the direction of the school bus drivers. **Elector Registration** (for voting day registration only)

There is no need to pre-register to vote as the registration of all electors for this election will take place at the time of voting. To register as a resident elector, you will be required to make a declaration that you meet the following requirements:

- \* You are 18 years of age,
- \* You are a Canadian citizen,
- \* You have been a resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding the day of registration,
- \* You have been a resident of the Village of McBride for at least 30 days immediately preceding the day of registration, and
- \* You are not otherwise disqualified by law from voting.

To register as a non-resident property elector, you must have obtained a Non-Resident Property Elector Certificate from the Village Clerk/Administrator. Only those individuals who own property may register as non-resident property electors - corporations do not have the right to vote.

**VOTER IDENTIFICATION**

RESIDENT AND NON-RESIDENT PROPERTY ELECTORS WILL BE REQUIRED TO PRODUCE TWO PIECES OF IDENTIFICATION (AT LEAST ONE WITH A SIGNATURE) TO PROVE IDENTITY AND/OR RESIDENCY IN ORDER TO VOTE. PICTURE IDENTIFICATION IS NOT NECESSARY. SOME EXAMPLES OF ACCEPTABLE IDENTIFICATION ARE: DRIVERS LICENCE, BCID CARD, ICBC INSURANCE CERTIFICATE, SOCIAL INSURANCE CARD, CREDIT OR DEBIT CARD, PROPERTY TAX NOTICE OR UTILITY BILL.

- \* the elector is an election Official.

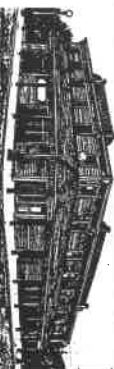
