

GENERAL VOTING DAY will be open to qualified electors of the Village of McBride on Saturday, November 16, 2002 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. at the following location:

Village of McBride Municipal Offices 100 Robson Centre McBride, B.C.

Elector Registration (for voting day registration only)

There is no need to pre-register to vote as the registration of all electors for this election will take place at the time of voting. To register as a resident elector, you will be required to make a declaration that you meet the following requirements:

- You are 18 years of age,
- You are a Canadian citizen.
- You have been a resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding the day of registration,
- You have been a resident of the Village of McBride for at least 30 days immediately preceding the day of registration, and
- You are not otherwise disqualified by law from voting.

To register as a non-resident property elector, you must have obtained a Non-Resident Property Elector Certificate from the Village Clerk/ Administrator. Only those individuals who own property may register as non-resident property electors - corporations do not have the right to vote.

VOTER IDENTIFICATION

RESIDENT AND NON-RESIDENT PROPERTY ELECTORS WILL BE REQUIRED TO PRODUCE TWO PIECES OF IDENTIFICATION (AT LEAST ONE WITH A SIGNATURE) TO PROVE IDENTITY AND/OR RESIDENCY IN ORDER TO VOTE, PICTURE IDENTIFICATION IS NOT NECESSARY. SOME EXAMPLES OF ACCEPTABLE IDENTIFICATION ARE: DRIVERS LICENCE, BCID CARD, ICBC INSURANCE CERTIFICATE, SOCIAL INSURANCE CARD, CREDIT OR DEBIT CARD, PROPERTY TAX NOTICE OR UTILITY BILL.

Advance Voting Opportunities

Advance voting will be open at the Village Office, 100 Robson Centre, McBride, B.C. on Wednesday, November 06, 2002 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.. The only persons permitted to vote at an Advance Voting Opportunity are those who, being duly qualified electors, sign a statement that:

- the elector expects to be absent from the Village of McBride on general voting day,
- the elector, for reasons of conscience, will be unable to vote on general voting day,
- the elector will be unable to attend a voting place on general voting day for reasons beyond their control,
- the elector has a physical disability or is a person whose mobility is impaired,
- the elector is a candidate or candidate representative, or
- the elector is an election Official.

A special voting opportunity will be made available at the McBride and District Hospital from 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. and at the Beaverview Lodge from 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, November 16, 2002. Only those qualified electors who are patients, residents or staff of the McBride and District Hospital or the Beaverview Lodge at the time of voting may vote at this special voting opportunity.
