### McBride Greda

McBride CREDA has been in operation since 1984 offering a variety of continuing and community education courses – from bookkeeping to tie-dye, from bath bombs to word processing, from art to first-aid and everything in between.

Until this year, most of the operating money to fund the building overhead and wages of a program administrator came from the College of New Caledonia in the form of an annual grant of \$12,500. With the cut-backs at C.N.C. this annual grant is no longer

At the present time, CREDA is trying to redefine its role in the community. Over the past few years, there has been a steady erosion of demand for the courses we had offered. Some was due to a changing economy (less demand for airbrakes, first aid, etc.), some was due to other agencies offering their own training courses (government agencies offering computer training or the High School offering upgrading) and some was due to a decline in the amount

offering upgrading) and some was due to a decline in the amount of disposable income people had to spend on courses.

The CREDA Board believes that the courses, information and other community-building aspects offered have been valuable and that the need for them may change but will not diminish. The challenge in our struggling economy is to find a way for CREDA to survive so we can offer courses and other services to the community.

An informal survey to gauge community support for CREDA was conducted last spring. Over 98% of the respondents supported the value and continuity of CREDA.
