Always check out sales call from unknown persons or organizations before you buy. Legitimate callers have nothing to hide. / The following tips may help you identify a telephone scam: The caller \*promises a gift or valuable prize if you make a purchase or pay a small fee or tax. \*requests that you give your credit card number or write out a cheque to be picked up by courier before you can fully consider the offer. \*uses high pressure sales techniques and refuses to take "no" for an answer. \*insists that you buy or invest "without risk."
