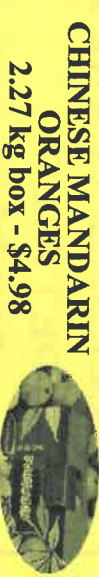

POLICE REPORT

November 15, 2002 - RCMP were alerted to an alarm at a local business on Main Street. The alarm was concluded as false upon attendance.
November 16, 2002 - A complaint of an intoxicated male refusing to leave a local establishment was reported in the early evening. The male was causing a disturbance with staff and other patrons. The police immediately attended but the subject was already gone.
November 19, 2002 - A report from Questel RCMP was received requesting assistance in locating an overdue traveller. The male was possible missing between Edmonton and Quesnel and had not been heard of since the 16th of November. All queries failed to locate the individual in our area.
November 20, 2002 - Mischief to a vehicle was reported within the village. The gas tank cap on the vehicle had been sprayed with paint. This matter is currently under investigation.
November 21, 2002 - RCMP received a report of a possible Time Share scam alert. The complainant had received a telephone call from a company wanting to sell their Time Share. The company sounded very convincing and money was passed onto the company. The phone number that was provided on the faxed contract is always busy and the 1-800 number is no longer in service. The e-mail address that was provided does not exist.
The remainder of the calls were of general nature and routine in service.

*RCMP would like to inform the public of a few tips to help safeguard you against Deceptive telemarketing:

Although most telephone sales calls are from legitimate businesses or charities, unscrupulous persons also use the telephone to trick unsuspecting consumers out of their money. Victims of phone scams seldom get their money back.
IF IT SOUNDS TOO GOOD TO BE TRUE, IT PROBABLY IS!
Always check out sales call from unknown persons or organizations before you buy. Legitimate callers have nothing to hide. / The following tips may help you identify a telephone scam: The caller *promises a gift or valuable prize if you make a purchase or pay a small fee or tax. *requests that you give your credit card number or write out a cheque to be picked up by courier before you can fully consider the offer. *uses high pressure sales techniques and refuses to take "no" for an answer. *insists that you make a purchase right away. *won't provide you with references you can check, or any reference at all. *suggests that you buy or invest "without risk."

Deceptive telemarketing practices violate the Competition Act. The Competition Act is a federal law enforced by the Competition Bureau. If you or someone you know has been the victim of a telephone scam, you may contact the Complaints and Public Enquiries Centre of the Competition Bureau.
