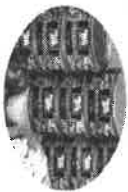

## POLICE REPORT

**February 12, 2003** - RCMP attended a single vehicle accident on Highway 16, west of the West Twin Bridge. A B-train loaded with lumber crashed on the bridge after the driver suffered a heart attack. The driver was transported to McBride Hospital by BC Ambulance Service. Ministry of Transportation also attended the scene and the lumber was moved off the highway. The driver is recovering from the heart attack.

**February 12, 2003** - McBride RCMP assisted Prince George RCMP after receiving information about a stolen white 2 door Dodge Neon in the ditch on Hwy. 16, west of the West Twin Bridge. The driver side window had been pried and the ignition of the car had been punched out. The victims purse and identification were still in the car. There are no suspects or witnesses.

**February 14, 2003** - RCMP received a complaint of mischief to residential property. The front door exterior window pane had been broken and no entry was gained. It is unknown what caused the broken window.

**February 15, 2003** - RCMP received another complaint of mischief to the same residential property. The front window had been broken in the residence. Again no entry was gained.

**February 16, 2003** - RCMP received yet another complaint of mischief to a vehicle registered to the owner of the residential property that had been previously damaged. The front windshield and side windows had been broken in the vehicle. These three incidents are currently being investigated and the RCMP are asking anyone who might have information, to please contact (250)569-2255. You will remain anonymous if you do not wish to give your name.

**February 17, 2003** - It has come to the attention of the RCMP that several trees have been cut down and a fire pit has been made on private property in the Dominion Creek area. The fire was still smouldering after 2 days and could have caused a lot of damage to the residential area, if it would have gone out of control. The property owner as well as the Volunteer Fire Department were advised. One of the parties involved in this incident was spoken to and warned of the various chargeable offences of trespassing and mischief.

**February 18, 2003** - RCMP responded to an alarm at a local business on Main Street. The alarm was concluded as false upon attendance.

**February 18, 2003** - RCMP received a complaint of 4 overduke sledders at 2:23 p.m. Search and Rescue located the sledders at approximately 9:30 p.m. Being as the weather was extreme on the Renshaw, the sledders decided to hunker down the night before and wait for the weather to clear. The weather did not clear, and it was impossible for them to know which way was out.

**February 19, 2003** - A complaint of a non injury motor vehicle accident was reported .5km west of McBride on Highway 16. Unfortunately the deer never survived and the vehicle sustained structural damage. The remainder of the calls were of general nature and routine in service.

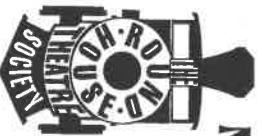

## MCBRIDE ROUNDHOUSE THEATRE SOCIETY PRESENTS

**John Reischmann and the Jaybirds** - Vancouver, British Columbia - based mandolin master John Reischman has assembled a truly international West Coast band for his latest exciting foray into the world of bluegrass music.

John is well-known to fans and peers alike for his powerhouse mandolin playing, first coming to prominence in the early 80s with California's legendary Tony Rice Unit and eclectic Good Ol' Persons. Since then he has carved out a well-deserved reputation in the elite upper stratosphere of mandolin players.

The rest of the Jaybirds are veterans Jim Nunnally on guitar and vocals, Trisha Gagnon on bass and vocals, Nick Hornbuckle on 5-string banjo and Greg Spatz on fiddle.

John Reischman and the Jaybirds are a band whose style is at once new and old; their blend of instrumental virtuosity, inspiring material and heartfelt vocals generate a live stage performance not to be missed.

**Swing Sonig** - Greg Leskiw - In 1969 Burton Cummings asked Leskiw to join The Guess Who. He went on tour with the group, won gold records and Juno Awards. In 1972, he left The Guess Who, formed his own Band, Mood Jga Jga. In the mid Eighties, Greg opened Vox Pop Studios in Winnipeg until 1997. Swing Sonic began life as a trio, with Leskiw and Greg Lowe both playing acoustic guitars and Daniel Koulack on acoustic bass. Lowe was replaced by Richard Moody on Viola. Currently, Bernie Addington provides the hard-swinging double bass.

Swing Sonig plays Hot Club jazz-the carefree, wide open, fast, dripping with energy jazz that lit up Paris between the two World Wars. They don't merely relive the past however. Their repertoire features a healthy dose of bluesy, country-tinged originals as well as classic jazz standards like Moonglow, It Don't Mean a Thing (If It Ain't Got That Swing) and The Hot Club signature tune Sweet Georgia Brown.

Leskiw provides thick, blues-drenched, smoke-infused vocals, giving Swing Sonig a modern edge. Richard Moody is absolutely amazing. His viola plays foil to Leskiw as Stephane Grappelli's violin did to Reinhardt in 1938. Bernie Addington is one of the best bassists on the Canadian jazz scene. He does exactly what the bass player is supposed to do, yet all too often doesn't - provide almost invisible support, then step out and blow people away with powerful, lyrical solos.
