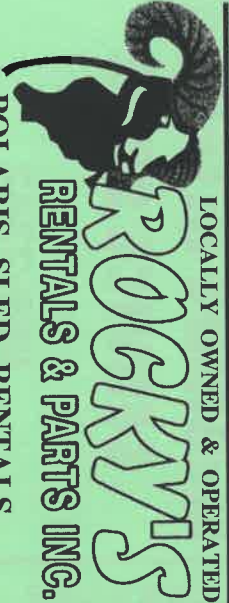

POLICE REPORT

March 07, 2003 - A report was received of a 2 vehicle accident, both traveling east bound near Horsey Creek on Highway 16. The first vehicle braked and the second vehicle hit the end of the vehicles trailer and subsequently went into the ditch. A total estimated damage was \$6000-\$7000 damage. There were no injuries as a result of this accident.

March 08, 2003 - RCMP received a report of a possible impaired driver traveling from 1st avenue east bound on highway 16. Patrols were negative.

March 10, 2003 - Approximately 65 km west of McBride a Dodge pickup traveling west bound on Highway 16 collided with a moose. March 11, 2003 - A single vehicle motor vehicle accident was reported at the King Creek Gravel Pit area on Highway 16. The truck rolled over in the ditch and subsequently the two occupants suffered minor injuries.

March 11, 2003 - RCMP would like to ask store owners to be on the look out for a possible money scam that may be going around the village. The subject goes into the store asking to exchange smaller bills for larger bills. When the money is exchanged the subject puts the money into a hand that already has bills in it and then gives it back to the clerk, claiming they have been short changed. The clerk cannot identify that money has been short changed because of the extra money in the other hand. If anyone has had any dealing with this type of report, please contact the RCMP and try to get a good description of the person, or a vehicle plate number.

March 14, 2003 - A report of a single vehicle accident with a deer occurred 58 km west of McBride on Highway 16. The car came up behind a logging truck and the deer came in between them. The car swerved but collided with a deer. There car suffered extensive damage and the occupants of the vehicle were not injured. The remainder of the calls were of a general nature and routine in service.

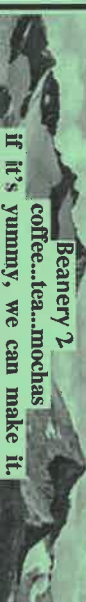
