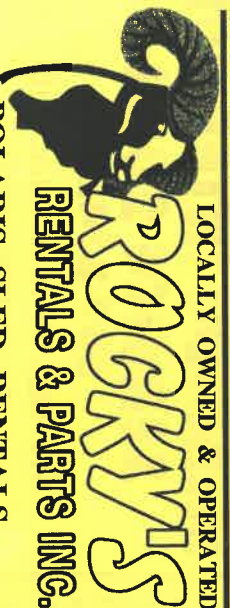

## POLICE REPORT

**April 02, 2003** - McBride RCMP were alerted to a suspicious female in McBride. The female had no identification with her and no belongings. Patrols were made and the female was confronted and brought in for questioning. The woman seemed to be very confused and was apprehensive in providing information as to her identity. After a thorough background check it was brought to the attention of the RCMP that the woman was an elope from Prince George Regional Hospital. The woman in her late forties was returned to Prince George via Ambulance.

**April 08, 2003** - RCMP received a report of mischief and theft to the same property 3 times in 10 days. The subjects have entered a locked area and taken small tools and other items while pulling things off of shelves and opening drawers. This matter is currently under investigation.

**April 10, 2003** - RCMP received a complaint of motorists travelling at high rates of speed on Mountainview Road. Motorists are reminded that the speed limit is 80km/hr on Mountainview Road. RCMP will be making patrols of the area.

**April 10, 2003** - RCMP received an abandoned 911 call. The residence was attended to after several calls were attempted and not received. It was founded that children had been playing with the phone, and there was no emergency.

The Reminder of the calls were of a general nature and routine in service.

**School Bus Safety Awareness Week** - March 24 to March 28, 2003: A couple of weeks ago was School Bus Safety Awareness Week from March 24 to March 28. This education/enforcement campaign has been undertaken to focus public awareness towards the many school buses that carry our children to and from schools. The responsibility of all motorists is to pay attention, and stop (in both directions) for the red flashing lights, and not proceed until the red lights on the school bus stops flashing. \*The fine for passing a school bus, in either direction, while the signals are deployed, is \$144.00. Provisions under the Motor Vehicles Act allow the registered owner to be charged for this offence, and the school bus drivers record and report any offender's licence plate details to the police. The traffic section investigates these complaints, and issue tickets for these violations. During the week, traffic officers were randomly "shadowing" school buses, as they pick up and return the children from school. \*Students from School District #57 were invited to participate in a poster contest, to increase awareness among themselves, and their families. Students from Dunster School of Fine Arts were one of the two winning schools that were recognized for their posters, thanks to the generous participation of our two sponsors, BC Hydro and McDonald's Restaurant of Prince George.

\*Remember that the school bus drivers have to deal with many distractions, weather conditions, children talking and moving within the bus, and motorists in a hurry to get to work. Safety of the students is the school bus driver's number one priority, and the purpose of our safety awareness week is to ensure that it is everyone's number one priority. When you see a school bus, please slow down, pay close attention to the lights and stop sign, watch for children, and obey the traffic signals when they are activated.

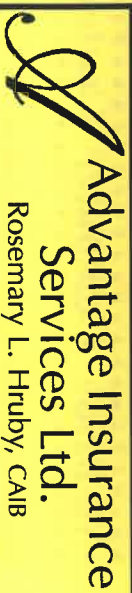
