POLICE REPORT

April 12, 2003 - A resident of Alberta reported that one of his snowmobiles was stolen from the Bell Mountain parking lot earlier in the afternoon. The investigation revealed that the individual was attempting to commit an insurance fraud by making a false claim. This person has been charged with Public Mischief and is scheduled to appear in court in McBride on July 04, 2003. This investigation would have probably never come to a successful completion if it wasn't for the exceptional observation made by the night watchman of the Sandman Inn. This is a prime example of the community working together with the Police to make McBride a safe place to live.

April 13, 2003 - RCMP received an abandoned 911 call from a local residence in the Village of McBride. When the residence was phoned back the answering machine would pick up and no verbal communication was established. The residence was attended and no one was home.

April 13, 2003 - A complaint of theft/vandalism to various street signs and posts around town was reported overnight. Some of the signs were stolen while others were either taken or knocked down. Some of the posts that were broken, were thrown into citizens yards. The total replacement cost was nearly \$2000.00. This matter is currently under investigation. April 14, 2003 - A report of a single motor vehicle accident involving a semi hauling MDF sheets was reported 83 km West of McBride on Highway 16. The semi went off of a blind corner and ended up in the ditch. The driver suffered minor injuries and speed was determined to be a factor in the crash.

April 15, 2003 - RCMP received a report that the loud speaker that was situated about the entrance to IGA was taken. The investigation is ongoing.

April 16, 2003 - A complaint of a disturbance on Main Street was responded to in the evening. One male was arrested for causing a disturbance after witnesses stated that he was trying to fight with everyone. The local male was lodged in cells until sober due to intoxication.
