POLICE REPORT

March 28, 2003 - RCMP received a report of theft of a child's Honda XR75 Motorbike. The motorbike was not visible to traffic and was tucked away at the location in which it was stored. Investigation is ongoing in this matter.

March 29, 2003 - RCMP responded to an alarm at a local business in McBride. The alarm was concluded as false upon attendance.

March 29, 2003 - A report of a motor vehicle accident was made. This incident occurred on Highway 16 just before Dome Creek and involved a lumber truck overturning in the ditch. The driver suffered minor injuries.

March 30, 2003 - A report of a Break and Enter at a local establishment was received. A ladder was placed against the building and the suspect gained access to the roof and cut the phone lines. No entry was gained into the building. This matter is currently under investigation.

March 30, 2003 - An abandoned car was reported on Dore River Forest Service Road. There were no licence plates on the vehicle and it was registered to a car dealership in Prince George. A 47 year old male from Alberta lost control of his snowmobile on a steep slope causing him to hit a tree. CPR was performed, however, attempts to revive him were negative. The victim was pronounced dead upon arriving at McBride Hospital. Alcohol is not believed to be a factor.
