VICTIM ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Robson Valley Police-Based Victim Assistance Program VOLUNTEERS NEEDED - This program is designed to assist victims of crime or traumatic events. Service is delivered through the local RCMP detachments and responds to referrals from the detachment members. The program's mandate is to provide the following: *listen to the victim's needs and concerns; *provide court preparation and court accompaniment; *provide information/updates on police and court procedures/files; *provide referrals to additional services. Interested applicants must: *work well with people in a crisis atmosphere; *be compassionate, understanding, and an effective listener; *have excellent communication skills; *be willing to work flexible hours, mostly nights; *willing to provide a commitment of 1 year minimum to the program. Due to the nature of the work, all potential volunteers are required to complete a detailed application, a letter of reference from a current/past employer, and two letters of personal reference. If successful, an interview will be conducted and an enhanced security clearance completed. All successful applicants will receive 20 - 30 hours of training and will be required to attend monthly staff meetings. It is imperative that all members of the program be responsible, reliable, and mature individuals who are sensitive to the needs and feelings of victims of crime. Strict confidentiality and professional courtesy must be exercised at all times. 


