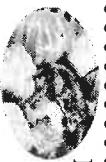

## POLICE REPORT

**BIKE SAFETY:** The RCMP would like to remind everyone that a helmet must be worn when riding a bicycle. Cyclists can receive a fine of \$29.00 if they choose not to wear a bicycle helmet. Also, keep in mind that riding on the sidewalks could result in an \$86.00 fine. If you want the same rights as a pedestrian at a crosswalk, you must get off your bike and walk it across the street. Please use extra caution when riding through traffic as you may not be seen by all motorists.

**NAME THAT FOAL CONTEST:** It is that time of year again when the Mares in Ottawa will be having their foals.
