POLICE REPORT

August 01, 2003 - RCMP responded to a single vehicle crash 60 km West of McBride on Highway 16. The 60 year old male from Edmonton was blinded by the sun and drove his blue Ford Taurus into the ditch. There was no damage to the vehicle and the driver was taken to the Hospital for treatment.

August 03, 2003 - A complaint of an impaired driver was received. A 30 year old man from Prince George was issued with a 24 hour Driving Prohibition and a Violation Ticket for Driving without due Care.

August 03, 2003 - RCMP responded to a single vehicle crash with a deer 60 - 80 km West of McBride on Highway 16. The Red Chev pickup driven by a lady from Houston B.C. was travelling East when the deer jumped onto the road. Although the deer did not survive the incident, there was only minor damage to the vehicle.

August 03, 2003 - An alarm was received at the Interior Roads complex. The property representative was notified of a fire alarm going off at the location. The McBride Volunteer Fire Department also attended and the alarm was due to a battery that had died due to the extended power outage.

August 04, 2003 - A report of vandalism on 3rd Ave. in McBride was reported. Two tires were slashed and the car was also keyed. There are no suspects or witnesses. If anyone has any information about this incident, they are encouraged to contact the RCMP at (250) 569-2255.

August 04, 2003 - A complaint was received of a group of males in a blue and white early 90's Ford extended cab parked at a rest stop 22 km East of the Village in which one of the males was indecently exposing himself to traffic. Patrols were made with negative results.

August 04, 2003 - RCMP responded to a complaint of an erratic driver driving a GMC Tahoe passing on a double solid line with excessive speeds. The vehicle was located doing 160 km/hr. in a 100km/hr. zone. The driver was issued a violation ticket.

August 04, 2003 - RCMP received a complaint of a blue minivan passing on a solid line and speeding. The vehicle was not located and the information was forwarded to Fraser Fort George Traffic Services.

August 05, 2003 - In the early morning hours two alarms were reported. One at the Elementary school and the other at the Secondary School. The alarms were of a cause of the power outage that was experienced in the Valley.
