Presents PIED PUMPKIN Friday, October 3rd at the Dunster Hall. Legendary B.C. folk trio Pied Pumpkin is here with a dance for all ages. Rick Scott, Joe Mock and Shari Ulrich combine dulcimer, guitar, violin, mandolin, flute and piano in a smorgasbord of folk, rock, jazz, blues and country. In the mid 70s PIED PUMPKIN was one of B.C.'s most beloved acts, recording several albums and winning thousands of loyal fans. After only two years together each Punkin went on to a successful solo career. In 1998 PIED PUMPKIN reunited just for fun and were greeted with such an overwhelming response that they have since played over 80 sold out shows across Canada. In March 2000 they released PIED ALIVE, a CD containing 13 musical polaroids recorded live in nine communities during their summer of '99 reunion tour. Punkin classics and newly written tunes mingle seamlessly on this first new Punkin recording in 25 years. PIED ALIVE complements the 1998 release of PLUCKING DEVINE, a CD retrospective of Punkin recordings previously only available on vinyl.

POLICE REPORT

September 19, 2003 - RCMP received a report from a traveller that they had lost their black Cockapoo female dog named "Missy", near the Kenneth Creek area west of McBride. The family had stopped on the side of the road to take a break and drove away thinking that the dog was in the vehicle. They returned to the site and the dog was not located. If anyone has seen Missy or may have picked her up, please call the McBride RCMP at (250)569-2255.

September 20, 2003 - In the early morning hours the RCMP were alerted to a noisy party in Hatchard's Trailer Park. Immediate attendance was made and all of the people were encouraged to go home. Everyone complied and the party broke up.

September 20, 2003 - Shortly after the previous party was broken up, RCMP responded to a disturbance on 2nd Avenue. The Party had carried over and some people were fighting. The incident was settled down and no further incidents were reported.

September 23, 2003 - RCMP were requested to assist the Village of McBride to serve a warning to a residence of McBride for a nuisance dog that has been running loose around town. September 24, 2003 - A complaint was received of an unwanted person at the McBride Hotel. The man was highly intoxicated and creating a disturbance with other patrons. RCMP attended and the man left without incident.

IT HAS BEEN BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF THE MCBRIDE DET. THAT MANY OF THE PRIVATE PROPERTY OWNERS WHO DO NOT APPROVE OF SHOOTING OR HUNTING ON THEIR PROPERTIES, BELIEVED THAT YOU MUST HAVE SIGNS POSTED TO BE LEGAL. THIS IS NOT THE CASE AT ALL AND IS ONLY AN EXTRA MEASURE TO FURTHER EMPHASIZE TO THE HUNTERS THAT YOU DO NOT ALLOW HUNTING OR SHOOTING ON YOUR PROPERTY. THE LAW IS CLEAR UNDER THE PROVINCIAL TRESPASS ACT AND IN SECTION 39 OF THE PROVINCIAL WILDLIFE ACT AS FOLLOWS:

TRESPASS ACT - THE PROVINCIAL TRESPASS ACT SETS OUT STRICT LIMITS ON ANY PUBLIC ACCESS TO ENCLOSED PRIVATE LAND. PRIVATE PROPERTY IS CONSIDERED ENCLOSED IF ANY ONE OF THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET:

- 1) THERE ARE CLEARLY VISIBLE SIGNS PROHIBITING TRESPASSING POSTED AT EACH ORDINARY ACCESS POINT.
- OR -THE PROPERTY IS SURROUNDED BY A LAWFUL FENCE; OR -THE PROPERTY IS SURROUNDED BY A NATURAL BOUNDARY SUCH AS RIVER BANK OR A 4 1/2 FOOT HEDGE.
- 2) WILDLIFE ACT (SECTION 39) - A PERSON IS NOT PERMITTED TO HUNT ON CULTIVATED LAND OR ON CROWN LAND WHICH IS SUBJECT TO A GRAZING LEASE WHILE THE LAND IS OCCUPIED BY LIVESTOCK, WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE OWNER, LESSEE OR OCCUPANT OF THE LAND.

The remainder of the calls were of a general nature and routine in service.
