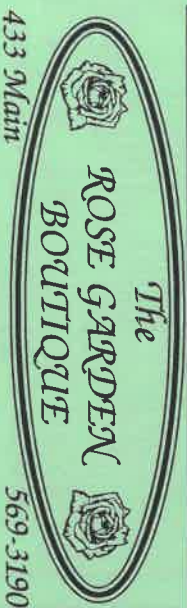

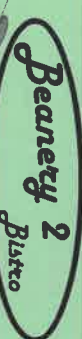

## POLICE REPORT

**October 10, 2003** - RCMP received a complaint of a Gas 'N' Dash on Main Street at approximately 8pm. The plate number that was obtained did not match the description of the vehicle involved in taking \$65,00 of gas. The information was forwarded to the Fraser Fort George Highway Patrol as there was a 20 minute time delay.  
**October 10, 2003** - The RCMP were contacted after a door window had been broke at the Rec Centre. Two males had been in an altercation and then left the scene once the window was broken. This matter is currently under investigation.

**October 11, 2003** - A report was made of a pickup in the ditch 2 km east of McBride on Highway 16. RCMP attended to the scene and the vehicle was towed. The owner was later located and the driver had been subject to a medical problem. There were no injuries sustained as a result of the accident and the vehicle was not damaged.

**October 11, 2003** - An incident was reported that minors had attended the McBride Hotel Bar. The minors were located outside and the manager stated that the minors had not been served and were asked to leave.

**October 13, 2003** - RCMP received a report of an overdue hunter. The teenage male had gone hunting on the backside of the Holmes River and had not returned. Search and Rescue was contacted and a search for the male ensued. The hunter was located walking down the Mountain and in good health.

**October 14, 2003** - A report was received of shots heard on private property. The owner of the property spoke with the hunter who finally left the area. The hunter had thought it was okay to hunt on the property.

**October 14, 2003** - RCMP received a report of a lost Olympus Digital Camera in the Dunster area. The camera was lost between River Road and Raush Valley Road. If anyone has located a camera in the area, please call the McBride RCMP at (250)569-2255.

**October 14, 2003** - A report of vandalism to an A-Train trailer was reported. The incident occurred between the 12th and 13th of October. The trailers which were parked on the South East Frontage Road in McBride sustained a severed airline and the main wires were pulled out of their plug causing several hours of repair to the owner.

**October 15, 2003** - A single vehicle, non injury crash was reported. The incident occurred the night before with a grouse. The vehicle sustained damage to the front grill.

**October 16, 2003** - RCMP received a report of an abandoned 911 call. A voice had asked for police and then hung up. The complainant was called back and it was stated that children were playing with the phone. The residence was attended to and everyone was okay.

**October 17, 2003** - RCMP responded to a false alarm at a residence on 2 avenue. The property representative had attended the residence and all was secure.

**October 17, 2003** - A single vehicle, non injured crash was reported 75 km West of McBride on Highway 16. The vehicle had collided with a deer causing damage to the vehicle involved. Unfortunately the deer did not survive the altercation.
