

POLICE REPORT

November 08, 2003 - RCMP responded to a complaint of an incident where a dump truck was backing up over a railway crossing in Dunster. The driver became distracted before noticing a Via Rail passenger train coming. The driver immediately put the vehicle into drive and the train nicked the back of the dump truck. There were no injuries but the train sustained approximately \$30,000.00 damage and the dump truck sustained approximately \$500.00 damage.

November 10, 2003 - A report of an alarm was received at 1000 3rd avenue. The location was attended and the alarm was concluded

November 11, 2003 - A complaint was received of theft of furnace oil from an unlocked compound within the village. A pipe had been broken to access the tank with over 100 litres being taken. The

matter is currently under investigation.

November 11, 2003 - In the late afternoon, RCMP responded to a single vehicle roll over 50 km west of McBride on Highway 16. The vehicle was going around a corner but never made the turn. The vehicle went into the ditch and rolled over. The driver sustained non life threatening injuries and was transported to Prince George Regional Hospital by BCAS.

November 11, 2003 - A report of a single vehicle roll over was reported at approximately 7:00p.m. The incident occurred 70 kms west of McBride on Highway 16. The driver lost control of the vehicle after slowing down. The vehicle fishtailed, slid into the ditch and rolled on its side. The two occupants of the vehicle were not injured and the car sustained major damage.
