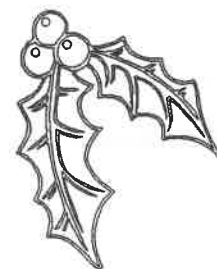

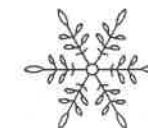

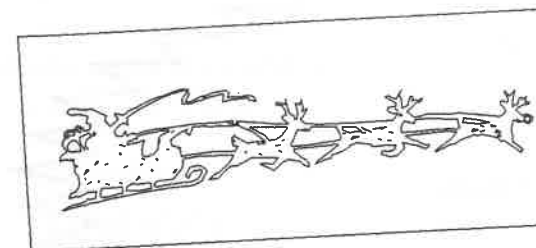
This year is shaping up to be a fantastic year with a lot of new and renewed interest. We are looking forward to fulfilling our Annual Chamber Events and projects with new energy.
