Notice is hereby given that The McBride Community Forest Corporation invites public review and comment of its proposed Forest Development Plan (FDP) for Salvage Non-replaceable Forest Licence A171884. This plan consists entirely of proposed minor salvage operations which may be carried out anywhere in the Robson Valley Timber Supply Area, excluding parks, protected areas, private land, the Canoe Mountain and Kinbasket Plateau Development areas, woodlands, community forest pilot agreement areas, and Bell Pole Replaceable Forest Licence A17799 operating area. Down to the Wood: Down to the Wood is an Alberta-based bluegrass the old fashioned way, coming together around one microphone to sing and play together. They play a mix of straight ahead traditional songs, instrumentals, and acappella numbers, as well as original interpretations of songs not normally associated with the bluegrass genre. The band has been playing together for over two years, coming together at a southern Alberta bluegrass festival to enter a band contest for fun. Since then, they have played at folk festivals, folk clubs, concerts and house parties. They have been featured on A-Channel's "The Big Breakfast" and CFRN-TV's "Good Morning Canada". Band members include Fort Saskatchewan native Curtis Appieton on banjo, guitar and vocals, Curtis played and recorded with Maple Creek, an Edmonton based bluegrass band, prior to joining Down to the wood. On bass and vocals, hailing from Peace River is Glen Hoffart. Glen's bluegrass pedigree includes a stint with Grass Routes, where he toured throughout the Pacific Northwest after recording their album, "Rural Route One". Marc Ladouceur is the main guitarist with the band, playing some mandolin when called upon, and helping out with the singing. Although relatively new to bluegrass, he played for a couple of years with a local Edmonton bluegrass band Critical Grass, gaining invaluable experience. The newest member to join the band is Bill Lopushinsky, the pride of Thorhild, Alberta, and long standing member of one of Canada's finest bluegrass bands, Jerusalem Ridge. Bill played mandolin and guitar for JR for over twelve years, made five recordings with them, and toured all throughout North America. Bill is also an accomplished lead and tenor singer. Down to the Wood plans to record their first CD this spring, and will release it in early summer. They have been booked at numerous festivals this year, and are very much looking forward to playing Dawson Creek's festival this year. **Yon can see Down to Wood, Saturday, January 17th, 8:00p.m. at the Roundhouse theatre.
