GARBAGE DISPOSAL

The McBride Regional Recycling depot and Transfer Station is operated by the Regional District of Fraser-Fort George. A site attendant is on duty during the following hours. Summer Hours: April 1 - October 31 Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday 9am-5pm. Saturday & Sunday 9am-4pm. Closed Wednesday. Winter Hours: November 1 - March 31 Monday, Thursday & Friday 9am-4pm. Saturday & Sunday 10am-4pm. Closed Tuesday and Wednesday. Holidays: The Transfer Station is open from 10am-2pm on holidays, with the exception of Christmas Day and New Year's Day, when the site is closed. The site provides opportunities for recycling, "Swap Shed" waste exchange area, residential waste disposal by way of an on-site transfer station, and limited commercial waste disposal. Recycling bins are provided to receive: *Metal Food Containers and Milk Jugs (rinse cans, remove labels, place lids inside cans and flatten) *Mixed Paper (cardboard, catalogues, glossy flyers, cereal boxes, office paper, kraft grocery bags, phone books, envelopes, magazines, newspaper, cardboard egg cartons. No paper with plastic, foil, wax, or food residue please) *Cardboard Compactor (remove all non-cardboard material such as plastic and styrofoam. Staples and tape can remain on boxes). The Legend Demolition and Construction Waste Landfill - Materials accepted for disposal include demolition and construction waste and landclearing debris. Disposal is by appointment only. The site also provides opportunities for disposal of large loads of source separate scrap metal for recycling. Disposal Permit Application forms are available from the McBride Transfer Station facilities or by contacting the Regional District. A tipping fee is a charge levied for disposal of waste and is based on volume and type of material. Tipping fees apply to all loads accepted at the site. Disposal application forms must be filled out in advance of any loads being accepted at the landfill site.

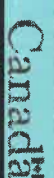
