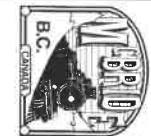

POLICE REPORT

January 09, 2004 - RCMP received a report that a vehicle sustained some damage after thieves tried to break in with a pry bar. The vehicle had been locked and a pry bar was used to try and gain entry to the passenger side door of the car.
