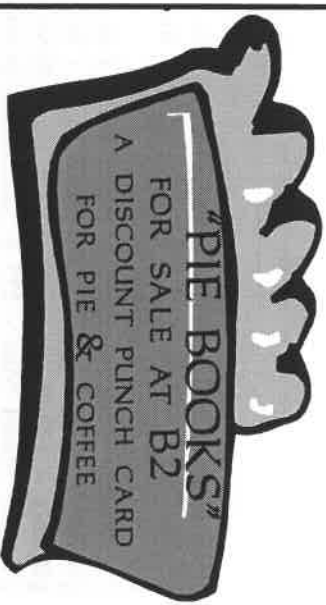

## POIICE REPORT
