PROESE, TYLER MARK

Tyler Mark Froese was killed in a motor vehicle accident, at the age of 23, March 4, 2004, while in Hawaii. Tyler was born in Chilliwack, B.C. June 20, 1980, raised on his great grandparents farm (Harold and Kate Young) until the age of nine when his family moved to carry on farming in McBride, B.C.

Tyler graduated from McBride Secondary School. He worked one year in McBride enjoying farming, ranching and carpentry. The following year he attended Capenway Bible School on Theitis Island. He finished his 4th year as a heavy duty mechanic apprentice in Grand Prairie.

He is survived by his parents Mark and Irene; brothers, Wayne, Jordan, Spencer, and sister Roberta, grandparents Len and Myrtle Froese, and grandmother Jean Mitchell. He is predeceased by his grandfather, Bob Mitchell.

Tyler will be remembered as a child for his sweet content spirit (a perfect first child) and his love for farming that carried on to adulthood. He had a contagious smile, was incredibly generous and never selfish.

To lose a man who lived with the spirit of Christ moment by moment is a tragedy yet because of his love for the Lord it has made it so much easier. Tyler's prayer was for us to all be right for God.
