POLICE REPORT

2004-03-20 - McBride RCMP investigated a complaint of uttering threats and assault with a weapon. A local male was arrested and charged with several counts under the Criminal Code of Canada. The male was remanded in custody to appear in Provincial Court in Prince George on the 25th of March. The male was subsequently released by the court and is bound by several conditions of bail. The investigation is continuing and further court dates are scheduled.
2004-03-22 - While on patrol, police witnessed a McBride motorist committing an offence under the motor vehicle act. The vehicle was stopped and an odor of marijuana was noted. A search of the vehicle yielded a small quantity of marijuana and a violation ticket was issued for the traffic violation.
2004-03-25 - A Prince George resident working in the area awoke to find his tool box including several items stuck as cork boots, various tools, and a chain saw were taken from the back of his pick up truck while parked for the night at a local motel. Anyone with information regarding this matter is asked to contact McBride RCMP. This matter is still under investigation.
2004-03-26 - McBride RCMP received a complaint of an intoxicated male causing a disturbance. Police attended the scene and the local youth was arrested and taken to cells where he remained until sober.
2004-03-27 - While patrolling the village in the early hours of the morning, police noticed a vehicle driving erratically on King Street. Upon questioning the driver, signs of impairment were noted and the local male was issued a 24 hour driving suspension.
2004-03-27 - A vehicle was checked at the Chevron Gas Station. Police noted open liquor in the passenger area. A subsequent search of the vehicle revealed a small quantity of marijuana. A violation ticket was issued to the driver under the liquor control act and the marijuana was seized for destruction.
