POLICE REPORT

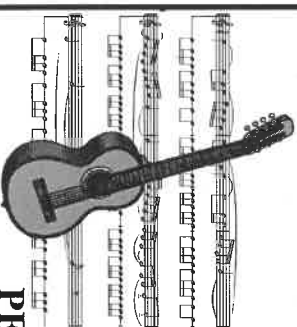
