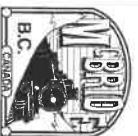

Your Child's Self Esteem – by Dorothy Corkille Briggs

Self image is your child's most important characteristic. *How to help create strong feelings of self-worth is the central challenge for every parent and teacher. The formula for how is spelled out in "Your Child's Self Esteem".*



Provides support to families who have children with diagnosed disabilities, developmental delays, or are at risk for developmental delays.

This program is for infants and children ages birth to 3 years. This is a home visiting program.

Through the use of developmental assessments, together with the family, we plan activities to support and assist the infant to reach their developmental milestones.

This program is free. Referrals to the visiting occupational therapist and physiotherapist are also available and we will soon have a speech therapist that comes every 6 to 8 weeks. There is also information on accessing funding help for travel etc. to meet your child's needs.

A list of services for children from 0-6 and their families has been compiled in each community for reference.

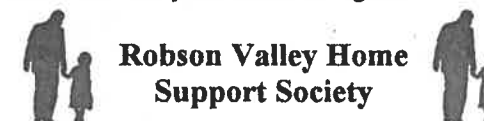


Infant massage will be offered in McBride at the Health Unit every Monday in June (7, 14, 21, and 27)
