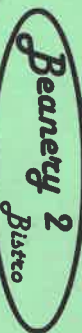

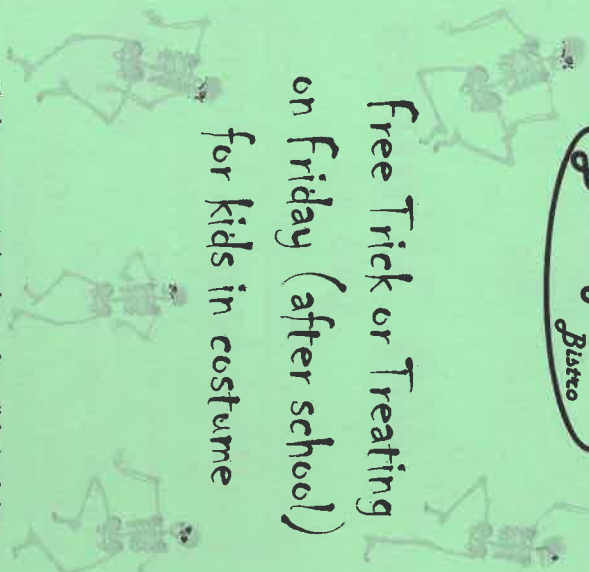

**POLICE REPORT**

On October 16th 2004 at approximately 6:00 p.m. McBride Detachment responded to a complaint of a Break and Enter to a rural residence west of McBride. The occupant of the residence came home to find her back door unlocked. As the occupant looked into the home she noticed that there were items out of place. The occupant took the correct action and immediately departed her home and went to use a neighbour's telephone to call the police. A member of the McBride Detachment attended and as he drove into the property he noticed a Motor home exiting the detached garage. The Motor home had no choice but to drive into the adjacent field as the police vehicle was blocking the driveway. The Motor home was followed by the McBride member for a short distance out into the field where the occupants stopped and surrendered to the member. Valenmount Detachment and the Police Service Dog from Prince George also attended to assist McBride members with the investigation. Charges of Break and Enter, Theft Over \$5,000, and Possession of Stolen Property were laid against an adult male and a female young person, both are from the Edmonton Alberta area. The adult male was remanded into custody to appear in Provincial Court in Prince George. The female young person was released to her parents on an Undertaking both will be making appearance in Provincial Court in McBride in the future.

The occupant of the residence deserves a lot of credit in taking the correct action in leaving residence to contact police immediately. Her action both allowed the police to attend in a timely manner and it also may have saved her from confronting the accused persons. Anyone that may have seen anything suspicious west of McBride on or near Highway 16 during the afternoon or early evening of the 16th of October is asked to contact the McBride Detachment at (250)569-2255 or Crime Stoppers at 1-800-222-TIPS(8477).

McBride Detachment responded to several motor vehicle accidents due to road condition on the 22nd of October. One single vehicle accident on Highway 16 at the Dunster intersection sent two McBride residents to the McBride Hospital. One of the injured was later transferred to Prince George Regional Hospital with a fractured wrist. Neither occupant were wearing their seatbelts which added to the severity of their injuries. Unfortunately winter has arrived, everyone is reminded to start thinking about their driving habits and to make the annual change, unfortunately a little earlier, to slow down for road conditions.
